*"Always more complete and nuanced than the Malbecs from the individual soils, the 2016 Malbec Finca la Escuela has the complexity of some full clusters and some variations that aren't introduced in the "soil" cuvées in order to keep them as simple as possible. It has the floral varietal character and the chalkiness of the Paraje Al-tamira limestone soils. It has very good freshness and very fine tannins, in a rare combination of power and elegance."*

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
