### **Argento Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva**

#### **TASTING NOTE**

Dark purple in colour, Argento Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon offers enticing aromas of black plums, black cherries and cassis. Complex flavours of blackcurrant, with a touch of cedar and herbs, give this wine a full mouthfeel, while nine months of ageing in predominantly French oak provide an elegant structure and good body with smoothly textured tannins.

Stainless steel fermentation at 25-27°C for 7 days
