## **BODEGAS LA RURAL** **Trumpeter Malbec**

### **Varietal**

100% Malbec

### **Vineyards**

Vistalba district in Lujan, Mendoza

### **Process**

destemmed for a 15 day fermentation and maceration

### **Malolactic Fermentation**

100%

### **Ageing**

30% aged for 6 months in new French oak

### **Alcohol**

13.5%

### **Total Acidity**

5.25 g/l

### **Winemaker's notes**

Aromas of cinnamon and berries lead into flavours of cherry, blackberry and plum intermingles with hints of cardamom and pepper. A rich, creamy wine with intense tannins, a touch of vanilla toast and a long, full finish.
