

CHATEAU LOUMELAT **2015 Cuvee JJ Lesgourgues Blaye Red**

Tasting Notes

Deep garnet red robe. Intense nose based on fruits, with blackcurrant and blackberry dominance. Toasted and vanilla hints, coming from French oak barrels vinification. Clearly defined and pure start, well balanced between fullness and tannins structure. Complex mouth and long tasting.

Food Pairing: To be enjoyed with meats (knuckle of pork, roasted poultry), and perfumed cheeses (goat cheese, Crottins de Chavignol).
