Tasting Notes

The Stonehedge 2005 Napa Valley Cabernet is a classic example of Cabernet's character and structure. It has aromas of black cherries, dried flowers, and smoky oak, with a hint of chocolate. The aromas integrate with the flavors of rich cherries, vanilla and crème brulee. The wine has a well-balanced acidity and soft tannins to balance the strong fruit flavors.
