

## **TERRABIANCA**

### **2013 Campaccio IGT Tosacana - Sangiovese/Cabernet**

#### **Varieties**

70% Sangiovese and 30% Cabernet Sauvignon

#### **Vineyard Characteristics**

From vineyards located in Radda in Chianti and Massa Marittima, Maremma, 350-412 meters (1,150-1,350 feet) and 200-260 meters (650-850 feet) above sea level respectively, with southwestern exposure and a calcareous-cretaceous substrata of sand and clay in Radda and northwestern exposure and loamy textured soil and red earth in Maremma; vine density is 2,260-2,510 plants per acre; vines are 8-20 years old.

#### **Vinification**

The grapes are selected at the winery before being approved for separate vinification in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature.

#### **Aging**

Aged in French oak (300 liter) for about 12 months and in bottle for at least 12 months.

#### **Tasting Notes**

Lively, deep ruby color; bouquet of brushwood and berry fruit, cocoa, toasted almonds and leather; structure, concentration and freshness are perfectly balanced on the palate. Complex, elegant, with full body and smooth tannins.

#### **Aging Potential**

Up to ten years Serving Suggestions: Best served at 16-18 °C (60.8-64.4 °F). Pairs well with red meats, game, and aged cheese. Analysis: Alc. cont. 13.5% by vol. Average Production: 100,000 bottles
